## Abstract

Chaungzon Township is located in Mawlamyine District and called as Retkha Depa in the past. And also, it is known as Bilu Kyun. Water is all around and it is a separated island. It is composed of only three wards, 44 village circles and 78 villages. The native people, especially children, study basic education in basic education schools, monastic education school and private school. They attend in Mawlamyine University for higher education. Medical staff, and the volunteers as well as Non-Government Organizations (NGO) take care of native people's health. Most of Mon live there and they hold their traditional festivals annually. Buddhism is their main religion but there is freedom of worship for other religions. For the development of socio condition of Chaungzon, there are four land roads and four waterways, and village adjoining streets are built in the region.
